

University Entry Information

Star Scheme – Southern Cross University early entry

Apply here - <http://scu.edu.au/futurestudents/index.php/29/>

What you need:

- Student number (BOS number – get off Mr Ella)
- Two course preferences
- All your contact details.
- Please note that you still need to complete a QTAC or UAC application. If you are choosing to apply for Griffith as well. Put your Southern Cross Star scheme through QTAC.

Applications close on Wednesday 9th September 2015.

Griffith University Early Entry

You have to apply through UAC. You cannot apply to Griffith anymore.

What you need to do:

- Complete a UAC application before you apply for early entry the UAC's School Recommendation Scheme (SRS)
- Student number (BOS number – get off Mr Ella)
- Have your UAC pin that was sent to you. If you do not have this you need to contact UAC about this on 1300 275 822.
- Follow instructions from page 21 in the UAC book.
- All your contact details.
- Give permission for somebody to act on your behalf.
- The courses you want to choose, you can have 9 preferences with UAC. Have the early entry as your first preference. Use the UAC books to find the course and course codes.
- At the completion of your UAC application you need to pay a \$32 application fee
- Write down your application number and new password.

This is your early entry application.

- You must apply for undergraduate admission before submitting your SRS application. You'll need your UAC application number and UAC PIN to apply.

- Your application must be submitted by midnight on 30 September 2015.
- If you need to upload documents, you can do this during your application or in SRS Check & Change after submitting your application.
- You will be unable to delete any Year 11 studies or awards and achievements once you have added them to your SRS application.
- You can only submit one SRS application.
- Review your application carefully before you submit it. You can make any changes before submission by clicking any of the edit buttons within the application.
- After submitting your application, download your SRS Confirmation package which contains a summary of your application details and instructions on uploading documents to support your application, if necessary.
- Applications can be completed seven days a week except between midnight and 7.30am Sydney local time.
- You can quit at any time and continue your application later. Remember to save your changes.
- Your application will time-out if you don't enter any information for 30 minutes.

QTAC Application

If you have applied for Southern Cross University Star Scheme, or just want to apply for a Queensland University you need to submit a QTAC application.

What to do:

- Create an account with QTAC
- Know your student number
- Confirm all details and include a mobile Phone number
- Give somebody permission to act on your behalf.
- And complete the application. Check Page 42 of QTAC booklet in ordering preferences correctly.
- If you have applied for early entry to Southern Cross University, ensure the course you have applied for is your first preference to accept it.
