



## A new personalised learning opportunity for the North Coast

Kingscliff High School is joining with Big Picture Learning to bring their personalised design for learning to young people in the North Coast, within a mainstream setting.

Research tells us that we learn best when we are personally motivated. Where there is passion for what we are doing, deep knowledge evolves naturally.

In Big Picture, students learn through their personal interests and design their own learning around a unique set of passions, needs, preferences and goals.

Students are supported to learn outside school on regular internships with expert mentors in the community, to test-out their interests, grow their network of contacts and to plan their future pathway to employment, training or study.

# What is the Big Picture design for learning?



Each student has a personalised learning plan designed around their interests and passions, with links to the curriculum.



Students take courses and work on a variety of projects in areas of personal interest that they design and manage.



Students learn in small groups of 17 known as an 'advisory' where there is a culture of belonging, support and respect.



They also complete practical projects while on internship with an expert mentor in the community, to gain experience in a field of interest.



Students collect evidence of their learning in a portfolio and regularly present their work at a public exhibition. This is the basis of their assessment throughout school.



The International Big Picture Learning Credential is an education passport awarded to all senior students on pathways to employment, training and university.

- 1. What are TWO of your current interests or passions right now and tell us, in detail, why they are important to you?
- 2. What positive things would people in your life (eg. friends, kinship/relatives, coach, teacher, neighbour) say are your strengths?
- 3. Why do you think the Big Picture design suits you as a learner?

To submit your answers to the Application Questions above choose ONE of the following options - A or B:


- A) Complete as a written submission via the online google form
