TASK

 - 3. Current and suggested controls
 - 4. Research into who regulates this industry in NSW and the associated laws, regulations and codes of practices.
- Research can be completed in pairs but each student is to submit YOUR OWN individual assessment task.
- Each student will be supplied with a blank hard copy of the risk assessment scaffold this can be used to complete the risk assessment of the agricultural plot
- The final copy (that is submitted) is to be typed and printed out for submission to the teacher OR submitted via the Google Classroom
