Dear Parents / Carers

Stage 6 Subject Selection – updated additional information

I hope this email finds you well, and write to update you on the support we are providing to Year 10 students and their families in making the best possible choice of subjects for Year 11 in 2024 and Year 12 in 2025. In addition to online advice that has already been made available at: <https://sites.google.com/education.nsw.gov.au/khs-subject-selection-info> we will be providing an additional information day for students on Friday 18 August 2023 (**our Stage 6 Subject Selection Expo Day**) during which students will meet with subject specialists to learn more about the courses we are offering, leading to the HSC in 2025, and which would be most suitable for them.

The sessions aim to cover the following key areas:

- Overview of the subject offerings and course content.
- Insight into the importance of subject choices in relation to long-term goals.
- Guidance on how to make informed decisions that align with their strengths and interests.

The deadline for students to submit their choices has been **extended until Thursday 24 August 2023**.

I strongly encourage families to access subject details via <https://sites.google.com/education.nsw.gov.au/khs-subject-selection-info> and have conversations with their child about the subjects that will work best for them following our student Stage 6 Subject Selection Expo Day this Friday 18 August 2023.

- Students speaking to the Stage 6 Coordinator
- Students and parents speaking with their teachers during our upcoming **Parent Teacher night on Tuesday 22 August 2023**.
- There will be a **Parent Information Session at our school in the TLS at 6pm on Tuesday 22 August 2023** (held on the same date as the Parent Teacher Interview night). This information session will outline HSC requirements and how these inform subject selection for students.
- Individual interviews with students once initial subject choices have been submitted and collated.

- Find an E-mail from Kingscliff High School with "Yr11 Electives" as the subject
- Inside this e-mail there is a link and a WebCode, click the link and then enter the WebCode to select subjects
