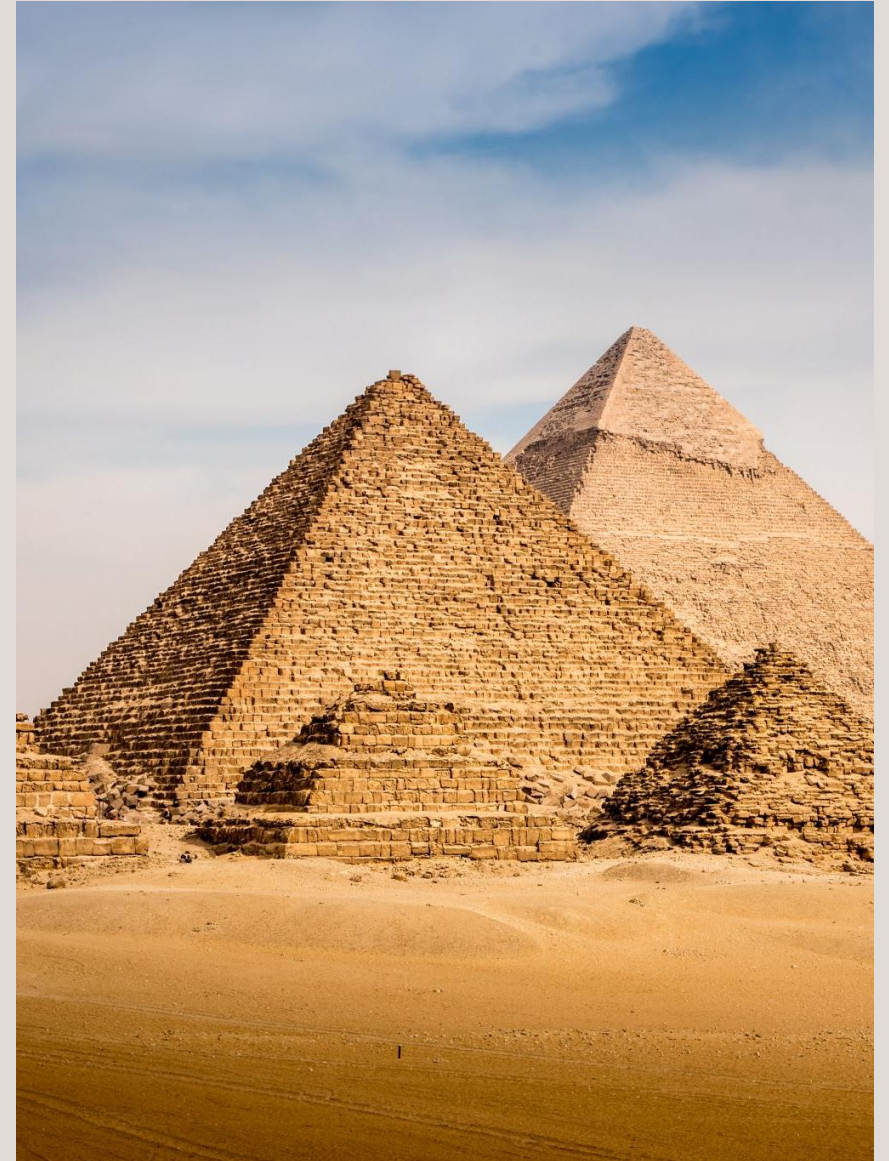

Elective History
