
TARGETED SPORTS PROGRAM- FUTSAL



The Program

The TSP- Futsal is designed to contribute to the development of 20 identified aspiring young athletes in the sports of futsal/ football, by providing them with a variety of sport specific learning experiences throughout the year.

In order to contribute to the development of these aspiring young athletes, TSP- Futsal athletes will-

- Participate in weekly sport specific training programs every Tuesday and Thursday from 7.30-8.30am. This will help develop them in their chosen sport by improving fundamental skills, knowledge and fitness.
- 2. Be provided with a variety of opportunities to compete and represent KHS in their chosen sport (refer Competitions outlined below).
- 3. Participate in the Talented athlete academic support program. This will allow them to access academic support in the school library on Wednesdays in lieu of attending sport or to sign out at the start of lunch times on Wednesdays to study at HOME, train or to recover. - Have access to high quality coaching and development opportunities through affiliated and complementary sporting bodies.
- 5. Develop their personal understanding and knowledge of training and health components that build successful athletes.

Competitions

2025 Veto Sports School Futsal League (SFL)

Comprises Boys and Girls teams in Under 14,16 and Open years age groups.

Format:

There are 4 Conferences across Queensland (North, South, Central and West), each comprised of 10 teams.

Each team plays 9 matches within their respective conference, with matches spread across 3 gala days (one in each of terms 1, 2 & 3).

The top 3 teams in each conference will qualify for the Champions Finals Gala Day.

Teams that finish 4th, 5th & 6th in each conference will qualify for the Shield Finals Gala Day.

Both finals will be played in Term 4 (Under 14 and 16) and Term 3 (Opens).

#ALWAYSVETO - Knockout Futsal Cup

Comprises Boys and Girls teams in the Under 14 years age group.

Format:

This is a Queensland and Northern New South Wales futsal knockout tournament that provides the opportunity for all schools to participate and compete against other schools within their district, region, and state, with visions of a future National competition.

It is divided into 8 conferences -

- 1. Capricornia / Wide Bay
- 2.Darling Downs / Southwest
- 3. Northern / Peninsula
- 4.Northern NSW
- 5.Metropolitan East / North
- 6.Metropolitan West
- 7.South Coast
- 8. Sunshine Coast

Each team competes in a Knockout Gala Day within their respective conference.

The winner from each conference then qualifies to participate in the Finals Gala Day at Coomera.

2025 North Coast CHS School Sports Association Futsal Competition

Comprises Boys and Girls teams in Under 14 and 16 years age groups.

Format:

There are 4 Zones across the NSW North Coast (Far North Coast, Richmond River, Mid North Coast, Lower North Coast)

Far North Coast comprises 10 schools that play a 1 day knockout gala day.

The winning team progresses to the North Coast Finals Gala Day to play against the winners from the other 3 Zones..
